

Lisbon is Portugal's hilly, coastal capital city. From imposing São Jorge Castle, the view encompasses the old city's pastel-colored buildings. Lisbon's trademark seven hills are spread across the cityscape like lofty guardians of colour and history. Seven cinematic hillsides overlooking the Rio Tejo cradle Lisbon's postcard-perfect panorama of cobbled alleyways, ancient ruins and white-domed cathedrals – a captivating scene crafted over centuries. Castelo de São Jorge- Towering dramatically above Lisbon, the mid-11th-century hilltop fortifications of Castelo de São Jorge sneak into almost every snapshot. Roam its snaking ramparts and pine-shaded courtyards for superlative views over the city's red rooftops to the river.

Its historic centre, lorded over by a colossal Gothic cathedral, is an intoxicating mix of resplendent Mudéjar palaces, baroque churches and winding medieval lanes. In many parts of the country you won't find anything but wines from Spain. La Rioja is the Spanish wine's heartland where you will find Bodegas Andrade vineyard and wine museum– Discover the ancient art of winemaking and taste top quality wines in a much more personalized experience. Flamenco clubs keep the intimacy and intensity of this centuries-old tradition alive. Seville's flamenco roots run deep. It mixes the gypsy music of the Romani people with the rhythms of North Africa, brought to Andalucía by the Moors - a rich blend that makes flamenco a unique form of artistic expression, whose irrepressible rhythm and anguished melodies lend Seville its passionate soundtrack. If you don't feel its rhythms singing through the winding streets and among the orange trees, or notice its bright colors dancing in the windows of countless stores, the city's souvenir stands will leave you in no doubt as they market Seville's heritage to the hilt.





DAY 08 (APRIL 15th) : BARCELONA/ZARAGOZA/MADRID



Zaragoza is the capital of northeastern Spain's Aragon region. Overlooking the Ebro River in the city center is baroque Nuestra Señora del Pilar basilica, a famous pilgrimage site with a shrine to the Virgin Mary and multiple domes

DAY 09 (APRIL 16th): MADRID

Toledo is an Ohio city at the western tip of Lake Erie. Synagogues, mosques and churches stand together in Toledo's historic quarter, a testament to the medieval Spanish city's diverse history. The four towers of The Alcazar, a fortress built in 1085, dominate the skyline. Toledo and its surrounding countryside inspired El Greco, and his paintings are on display in many places around the city, including the museum that bears his name.

GENERAL INFORMATION YOU NEED TO KNOW:

- Most rooms and washrooms in European hotels are small
